

# Zubri Patio Heater Instructions

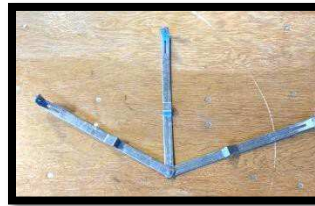

# Assembly Instructions

1. Remove the main body from the case and lay flat on the ground. **DO NOT stand on end where regular hangs.** This will damage the internal wiring and cause the heater to malfunction or leak propane. Refunds will not be provided if the heater malfunctions due to bent wiring.



2. Remove the three legs and attach to the lower portion of the main body.



3. Attach the gas bottle stand / stability brackets to the three legs. To secure the gas bottle stand, insert each of the securing nuts on the stand into each of the key-hole slots at the bottom of the heater legs and push downward.



4. Tilt the top of the main body up and attach the reflector:



5. Stand the unit on the three legs and position it where it will be used. Picture is for demonstration only. Do not use indoors.



6. Hang the propane tank on the hook located on the main body of the heater and attach the hose valve assembly to the propane tank by connecting the main heater body to the propane tank and turning the valve on the heater clockwise to secure it.

7. Open the valve on the propane tank by turning the knob on the tank towards the "Open" position (counterclockwise) SLOWLY. Opening too fast can freeze the tank due to the internal compression of the tank. If gas is not releasing close the tank and let it sit for 20 minutes. Then open the tank slowly and try again.



8. Follow the instructions attached to heater to light the heater



9. After the heater has been lit, attach the skirt to the legs portion of the heater
